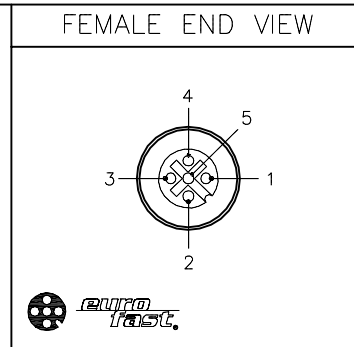
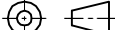




WIRING DIAGRAM
