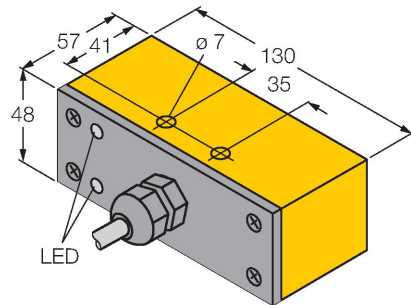

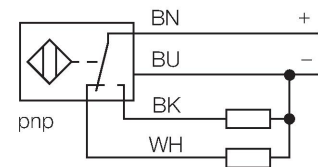
Inductive Sensor



Features

- Rectangular, height 48 mm
- Active face in front
- Plastic, PBT
- DC 4-wire, 10...65 VDC
- Changeover contact, PNP output
- Cable connection

Functional principle

Inductive sensors detect metal objects contactless and wear-free. For this, they use a high-frequency electromagnetic AC field that interacts with the target. Inductive sensors generate this field via an RLC circuit with a ferrite coil.

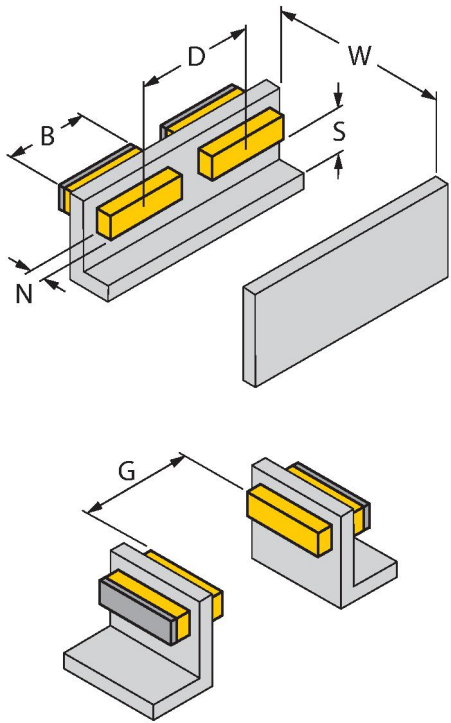
