Re: EPA Chemical Safety. **P**ersistent, **B**io-accumulative, and **T**oxic (PBT) Chemicals under TSCA Section 6(h)

As required under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), as amended by the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, EPA has issued five final rules in December 2020 to reduce exposures to certain chemicals that are persistent, bio-accumulative and toxic (PBT).

These rules limit or prohibit the manufacturer (including import), processing, and/or distribution in commerce (including within articles) the following 5 PBT Chemicals.

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1)(PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)
